



The top priority at the Multiple Sclerosis Center of Atlanta is the safety and well-being of our patients and staff. As we have all been challenged with the impact of COVID-19, the commitment to safety will not waiver. MSCA has created policies and guidelines following reputable sources such as, [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#) and [Occupational Safety and Health Administration \(OSHA\)](#) related to actions needed to minimize the risk and/or exposure. As changes have occurred, we have adjusted our policies with highest regard to safety.

MSCA currently policies include:

- **Mandating masks that cover both mouth and nose for all patients, visitors, and staff.** *This includes both individuals who have received the COVID-19 vaccination as well as those who have not received the vaccination.*
- **Require at minimum 6-foot spacing between individuals.**
- **Limit patients' guest to essentially needed persons with a maximum of 1 person per patient (essential guest to include caregivers and interpreters).**
- **Option to have a telehealth visit for follow up visits.**
- **Install screen barriers in the infusion suite between each chair.**

We ask that patients understand that our job is to protect all who enter our doors. Although views may differ, MSCA will take the highest level to protect our valued patients and staff. If you have received the COVID-19 vaccination, please know many of our patients have not received the vaccine for various reasons in which following the above policies is very crucial for both those who have a vaccine and those who do not.
